SCIENCE EXHIBITION

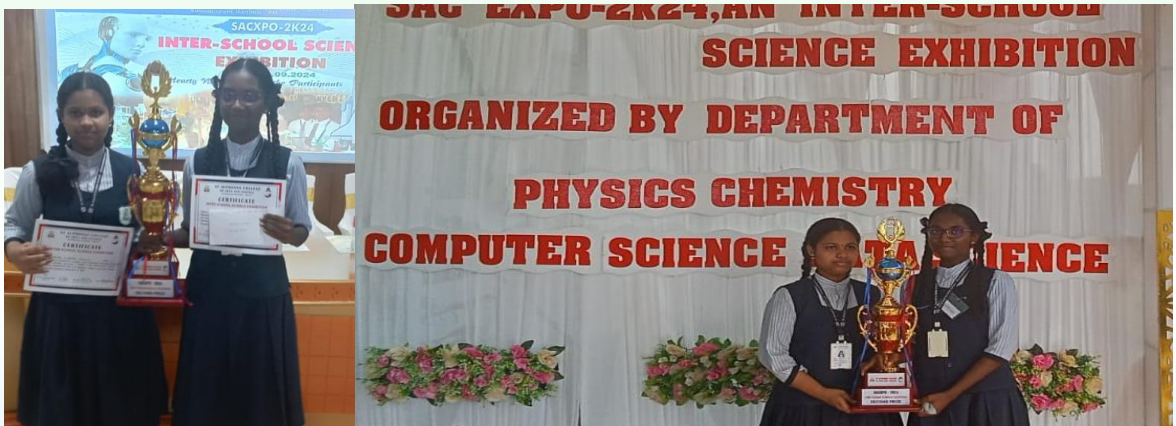
